

# POOL ETIQUETTE & INFORMATION

## Member Conduct

We strive to uphold a safe, clean and enjoyable environment. As such, we expect proper, respectful conduct on the premises at all times. Member conduct is expected to be of the highest standards. Use of profanity, physical or verbal abuse, harassment of other members or staff, or damage to facilities will not be tolerated and is cause for immediate revocation of membership privileges without a refund.

Lanes MUST be shared if necessary. A member CANNOT refuse to allow another member access to a given lane.

Use of pool space is first-come first-serve. Please refer to the Weekly Pool Usage schedules to note free and paid classes, times when all lap lanes or all warm pool areas are closed, special events, private lessons swim blocks, etc. The Weekly Pool Usage is posted on the bulletin board by the warm water pool. Our Quarterly schedule also serves as a resource.

Please utilize the pool diagram for reference of lanes that are available when classes and lessons are and are not in session.

Please refer to our extended pool etiquette for additional questions/guidelines.

## General Guidelines

- Pool patrons are expected to shower before entering pools and whirlpools – please refrain from wearing cologne and perfume.
- Appropriate swimming attire is required to enter the pool. We recommend wearing aqua shoes for classes.
- The use of the pool will be denied to any person having evidence of contagious disease or illness, rashes or open wounds.
- Please return all aquatic equipment to proper location when finished.
- Please set any personal belongings (fins, pull buoys, etc) on the North end of the lap pools in order to keep our walkways clear.
- No street shoes in the sauna.
- No cell phones should be used in the natatorium.
- Diving is not permitted. No jumping backward, spinning or flips off the side of the pools.
- No running on deck.
- No spitting in the pools.
- Exterior doors in pool area are for emergency use only.
- In case of emergency use the red phone on the South wall between the two pools. Dial 31-2640
- No lifeguards are on duty.
- Members and guests are not permitted to move lane lines without permission from a staff member.
- The natatorium will close 15 minutes prior to building closing.

## Children

- All children are invited to use the pool during our Family Swim times Fridays 6-8p (lap) and 7-8p (warm). Children on family memberships are allowed to use the pools at other times considering the family guidelines.
- Swim diapers are required for children not potty-trained.

## Food

- No food is allowed in the natatorium area.
- No glass containers are allowed in the natatorium area.
