Total number of children and adolescents treated in 2023: 7

Average age of children and adolescents treated in 2023: 16 years

Average length of stay for children and adolescents treated on our Rehab Unit in 2023: 10.4 days

Program facts

- 85.7% of our children and adolescent population were discharged home in 2023, once they achieved their established goals. The Advocate Lutheran General Hospital rehabilitation program exceeds regional and national averages in achieving independence with mobility, dressing, grooming, speech, language and mental skills.
- Our rehab team has the skills and capabilities of treating children and adolescent patients with a variety of medical and traumatic injuries.
- It is not uncommon for some patients to need additional medical attention and our physician can transfer patients to a medical floor in the hospital, if needed. 14.3% of our children and adolescent population transferred to the pediatric floor in 2023 for further treatment goals.
