- Most patients are discharged home when they have achieved their established goals. The remaining patients are discharged to a Skilled Nursing Facility or an Extended Care Facility to continue with their therapy goals.
- Patients can be transferred to a medical unit for planned and unplanned medical treatment/procedures.
- The Advocate Lutheran General Hospital rehabilitation program exceeds regional and national averages in achieving independence with walking, dressing, grooming, speech, language and cognitive skills.
- Patients we serve in our facility are more disabled and medically complex than other facilities in the region and nation.
- Patients receive a minimum of 3 hours a therapy per day, 5 days of the week.
