What to Bring to the Hospital

When you arrive at the hospital you will only need to bring in a small bag containing your labor supplies. Please leave all other luggage in the car. These other items can be retrieved after the delivery. Please leave all valuables at home. Average stay in the hospital for a vaginal delivery is 1-2 days and for a C-Section is 2-3 days.
