\$500 Million for community outpatient care

- 85,000 new appointments annually
- 10 new Neighborhood Care sites plus a mobile primary care unit
- An expanded Imani Village outpatient clinic on East 95th Street to add Immediate Care with more doctors, more services, more appointments and shorter wait times

\$300 Million for a new state-of-the-art replacement hospital near the lakefront

- Equipped with a cardiac catheterization lab, enhanced emergency department, leading-edge diagnostic testing and imaging, robotic surgical procedures and the latest technology to connect with specialty physicians quicker and more efficiently
- 52 beds with flexibility to meet growing community needs
